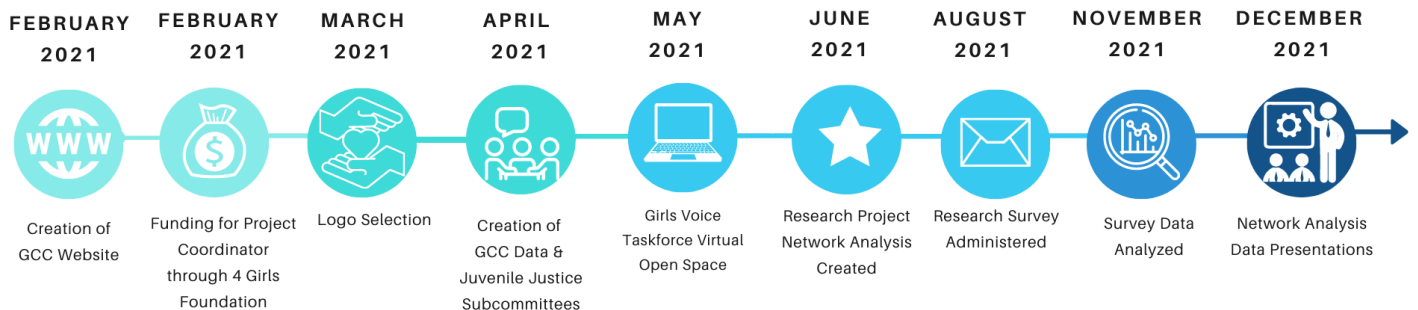

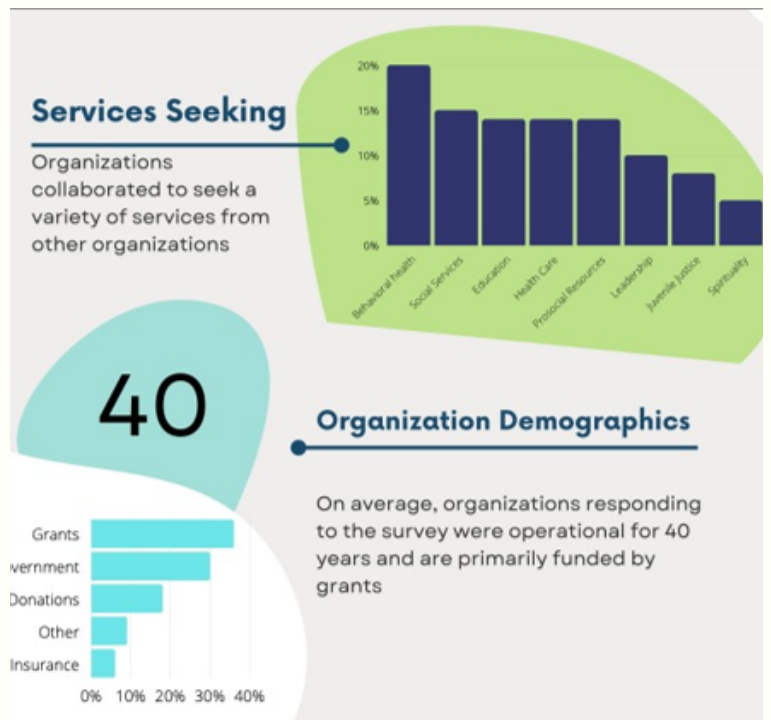

Network Analysis

The Girls Coordinating Council administered a survey 8/16/2022-9/16/2022 to analyze the network of mental health and juvenile justice service providers for girls in Palm Beach County. We received responses from 18 individual organizations, 10 of which are members of the Girls Coordinating Council. The initial results indicate that members of the Girls Coordinating Council are better connected with other organizations. The results also found that organizations tend to collaborate for information sharing more often than they collaborate for resource or referral sharing. We are still gathering information on the benefits and drawbacks of the collaboration and ask you to please participate in a follow-up interview to improve our research findings.
